**APPLICATION FOR OPEN BURNING PERMIT**

NOTE: This permit is valid only when in conjunction with the appropriate county health department Open Burning Permit.

**3. Mandatory Burning Regulations**

- A. Applicant must have a pre-approved site inspection in order to obtain a permit, which will be valid for one (1) calendar year.
- B. No open burning is permitted unless there is four (4) or more inches of snow on the ground by the burn site.
- C. No burning is allowed when winds are in excess of 10 m.p.h. If winds pick up during burn process, flames must be extinguished.
- D. Burning can only take place between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Fires must be completely out, with no residual smoke, by 4:00 p.m.
- E. At no time shall the burning be left unattended. Do not leave piles smoldering or burning overnight.
- F. Only clean, dry slash (branches six (6) inches or less in diameter) can be burned; no stumps, logs, or trunks. In addition, the burning of trash or construction-type materials is not permitted.
- G. All burns must have a charged garden hose (or other approved adequate water supply) at the burn site area, along with a shovel.
- H. No fire shall exceed a diameter of six (6) feet.
- I. Open burning is prohibited during a publicly announced air pollution alert, advisory prohibiting wood burning, or burn bans during periods of extreme fire danger.

Applicants must call the CCCFPD at 303-642-3121 and Boulder Communications Dispatch at 303-441-4444 **BEFORE** and **AFTER** each permitted burn. Jefferson and Gilpin County residences must **ALSO** contact their Sheriff's Dispatch Office at 303-277-0211 (Jefferson Co.) and 303-582-5500 (Gilpin Co.).

I, the undersigned, agree to the conditions above for open burning. I also agree to maintain flames no higher than three (3) feet, and diameter of fire base no more than six (6) feet . I will burn only Class A (ordinary) combustible materials, no hazardous materials or petroleum products will be placed into the open flame. The CCCFPD claims NO responsibility on approval of this permit. Applicant/Owner assumes all responsibility and liability for proposed burn. Applicant has read and agrees to the above regulations.
